2017 ARANSAS COUNTY RESOLUTION INDIGENT DEFENSE GRANT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the *Texas Government Code Section 79.037* and *Texas Administrative Code Chapter 173*, counties are eligible to receive grants from the Texas Indigent Defense Commission to provide improvements in indigent defense services in the county; and

WHEREAS, this grant program will assist the county in the implementation and the improvement of the indigent criminal defense services in this county; and

WHEREAS, Aransas County Commissioners' Court has agreed that in the event of loss or misuse of the funds, Aransas County Commissioners assures that the funds will be returned in full to the Texas Indigent Defense Commission.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the **Aransas County Judge** is designated as the Authorized Official to apply for, accept, decline, modify, or cancel the grant application for the Indigent Defense Formula Grant Program and all other necessary documents to accept said grant; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the **Aransas County Court-at-Law Judge** is designated as the Program Director and contact person for this grant, and the **County Auditor** is designated as the Financial Officer for this grant.


