

2012 ARMSTRONG COUNTY Resolution

Indigent Defense Formula Grant Program

Whereas, under the provisions of the Fair Defense Act, 77th Regular Session, counties are eligible to receive grants from the Texas Indigent defense Commission to provide improvements in indigent defense services in the county; and

Whereas, this grant program will assist the county in the implementation of the provisions of the Fair Defense Act and the improvement of the indigent defense services in this county; and

Whereas, the Armstrong County Commissioners Court has agreed that in the event of loss or misuse of the funds, the Armstrong County Commissioners Court assures that the funds will be returned in full to the Texas Indigent Defense Commission.

Now therefore, be it resolved and ordered that the Armstrong County Judge is designated as the Authorized Official to apply for, accept, decline, modify, or cancel the grant application for the Indigent Defense Formula Grant Program and all other necessary documents to accept said grant; and

Be it further resolved that the Armstrong County Treasurer is designated as the Program Director, contact person, and Financial Officer for this grant.
