



# Resolution

## *2016 Indigent Defense Grant Program*

**WHEREAS** under the provisions of the Texas Government Code Section 79.037 and Texas Administrative Code Chapter 173, counties are eligible to receive grants from the Texas Indigent Defense Commission to provide improvements in indigent defense services in the county; and

**WHEREAS** this grant program will assist the county in the implementation of the provisions of the Fair Defense Act and the improvement of the indigent criminal defense services in this county; and

**WHEREAS** Brazos County Commissioners Court has agreed that in the event of loss or misuse of the funds, Brazos county Commissioners assures that the funds will be returned in full to the Texas Indigent Defense Commission; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** and ordered that the County Judge of this county is designated as the Authorized Official to apply for, accept, decline, modify, or cancel the grant application for the Indigent Defense Formula Grant Program and all other necessary documents to accept said grant; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the County Auditor is designated as the Financial Officer for this grant.
