FY2022 HARDIN COUNTY RESOLUTION INDIGENT DEFENSE IMPROVEMENT GRANT PROGRAM
<b>WHEREAS</b> , under the provisions of the Texas Government Code Section 79.037 and Title I of the Texas Administrative Code Chapter 173, counties are eligible to receive grants from the Texas Indigent Defense Commission to provide improvements in indigent defense services in the county; and
<b>WHEREAS</b> , the Commissioners Court authorizes this grant program and application to assist the County in the implementation and the improvement of the indigent criminal defense services in this county; and
<b>WHEREAS</b> , Hardin County Commissioners Court has agreed that in the event of loss or misuse of the funds, Hardin County Commissioners Court assures that the funds will be returned in full to the Texas Indigent Defense Commission.
<b>NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED</b> that the Hardin County Judge is designated as the Authorized Official to apply for, accept, decline, modify, or cancel the grant application for the Indigent Defense Formula Grant Program and all other necessary documents to accept said grant; and
<b>BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED</b> that the County Auditor is designated as the Financial Officer for this grant.
