WHEREAS, this grant program will assist the county in the implementation and the improvement of the indigent criminal defense services in this county; and



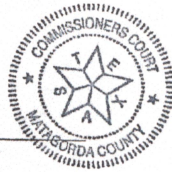

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Auditor is designated as the Financial Officer for this grant.






