## 2014 MCMULLEN COUNTY RESOLUTION Indigent Defense Grant Program

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the Fair Defense Act, 77<sup>th</sup> Regular Session, counties are eligible to receive grants from the Texas Indigent Defense Commission to provide improvements in indigent defense services in the county; and

WHREAES, this grant program will assist the county in the implementation of the provisions of the Fair Defense Act and the improvement of the indigent criminal defense services in this county; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the County Treasurer is designated as the Financial Officer for this grant.
