**2012 Oldham County Resolution
Indigent Defense Formula Grant Program**

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the Fair Defense Act, 78th Regular Session, counties are eligible to receive grants from the Texas Indigent Defense Commission to provide improvements in indigent defense services in the county; and

WHEREAS, this grant program will assist Oldham County in the implementation of the provisions of the Fair defense Act and the improvement of the indigent criminal defense services in Oldham County; and

WHEREAS, Oldham County Commissioners Court has agreed that in the event of loss or misuse if the funds, Oldham County Commissioners assures that the funds will be returned in full to the Texas Indigent Defense Commission.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED and ordered that the County of Judge of Oldham County is designated as the authorized Official to apply for, accept, decline, modify, or cancel the grant application for the Indigent Defense Formula Grant Program and all other necessary documents to accept said grant; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Charlotte Cook, Oldham County Auditor is designated as the Program Director and contact person for this grant and the County Auditor is designated as the Financial Officer for this grant.
