
WHEREAS, this grant program will assist the county in the implementation of the provisions of the Fair Defense Act and the improvement of the indigent criminal defense services in this county; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Hugo Martinez, Chief Public Defender is designated as the Program Director and contact person for this grant and the County Auditor is designated as the Financial Officer for this grant.
