

In accordance with the Texas Fair Defense Act, as adopted by Senate Bill 7 and included in Texas Code of Criminal Procedure, the 112<sup>th</sup> District Court Schedule of Fees for Counsel of Indigents shall be amended as follows:

#### 112<sup>th</sup> District Court SCHEDULE OF FEES FOR COUNSEL OF INDIGENTS

The following schedule of fees is on an hourly basis with no differential between out of court and in court time unless otherwise stated:

- A. State Jail; Third Degree; Second Degree; First Degree  
\$90.00 per hour
- B. Capital Felonies:  
\$125.00 per hour First Chair; \$100 per hour second chair
- C. Appellate Briefs  
\$90.00 per hour
- D. All Motions to Revoke Probation and Motions to Proceed to Adjudication  
\$90.00 per hour
- E. Class A&B Misdemeanors  
\$90.00 per hour
- F. If an attorney is able to resolve a case before working at least 8 hours on a matter, a \$500.00 flat fee may be requested and paid to the attorney.

#### Juvenile Schedule of Fees for Counsel of Indigents

Initial Detention Hearing: \$100.00

Subsequent Detention Hearing: \$100.00

Disposition and Adjudication Hearing (Plea of True): \$300.00

Contested Hearing and Trials: \$300.00 per half day, plus up to an additional \$500.00 for trial preparation with prior approval by the trial judge.

Appeals \$1,000 per case
