

**STANDING ORDER FOR COMPENSATION OF ATTORNEYS
APPOINTED TO REPRESENT INDIGENT DEFENDANTS AND JUVENILES**

On the 16th day of December, 2009, the below named County and District Court Judges with criminal jurisdiction, also constituting the Gray County Juvenile Board, after a duly called and conducted meeting and discussion, did unanimously adopt this schedule of fees concerning compensation of court-appointed counsel for indigent defendants and juveniles and related expenses made pursuant to Article 26.05, Texas Rules of Civil Procedure; therefore, it is ORDERED that compensation of court-appointed counsel and related expenses, made pursuant to a motion in the format prescribed by the appointing court, shall be as follows on a case-by-case basis as determined by the judge:

I. SCHEDULE OF FEES

A. Non-Jury Trial and Hearings:

\$350.00	Misdemeanor Pleas
\$250.00	Misdemeanor Revocation of Probation
\$150.00	Misdemeanor Dismissals
\$350.00	Juvenile Pleas
\$250.00	Juvenile Non-TYC Modifications
\$350.00	Juvenile TYC Modifications
\$650.00	Felony Pleas
\$350.00	Felony Revocation of Probation
\$250.00	Felony Dismissals

B. Jury Trials, Unusual Cases, Appeals:

Maximum hourly rate, except for unusual cases or appeals, with advance approval of estimated fee by the Presiding Judge, \$100.00 per hour with maximum daily rate is \$750.00
