STANDING RULES AND ORDERS FOR
PROCEDURES FOR TIMELY AND FAIR APPOINTMENT OF COUNSEL
FOR INDIGENT ACCUSED PERSONS
FY 2023 & 2024

Whereas pursuant to the requirements of the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure and the Texas Government Code, the County Court Judge and the 84th District Court Judge for Hansford County, Texas are required to adopt a plan to furnish counsel to indigent accused persons; and


Whereas prior plans have been adopted and submitted to the Texas Task Force for Indigent Defense and these plans and all required supplementations now appear on the website for the Task Force and are published on the website as the current plan for appointed counsel;

RESOLVED, that the contents of the Hansford County and District Court Plan FY 2023 & 2024, together with the attached forms and Appointed Counsel Fee Schedule, be adopted as the Hansford County, Texas, Standing Rules and Orders for Procedures For Timely and Fair Appointment of Counsel for Indigent Accused Persons FY 2023 & 2024.

This plan is adopted, to be effective October 1, 2022, by resolution of the County Court Judge and the 84th District Court Judge for Hansford County, Texas, duly passed, signed and ORDERED this the 20TH day of July, 2022.
