


**HUTCHINSON COUNTY, TEXAS  
STANDING RULES AND ORDERS FOR  
PROCEDURES FOR TIMELY AND FAIR APPOINTMENT OF COUNSEL  
FOR INDIGENT ACCUSED PERSONS IN  
FY 2023 & 2024**

Whereas pursuant to the requirements of the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure and the Texas Government Code, the County Court Judge and the 84<sup>th</sup> and 316<sup>th</sup> District Court Judges for Hutchinson County, Texas are required to adopt a plan to furnish counsel to indigent accused persons; and



RESOLVED, that the contents of the Hutchinson County and District Courts Plan FY 2023 and 2024, together with the attached forms and Appointed Counsel Fee Schedule, be adopted as the Hutchinson County, Texas, Standing Rules and Orders for Procedures for timely and Fair Appointment of Counsel for Indigent Accused Persons FY 2023 & 2024.


