

§5.02. Mileage reimbursement

The Juvenile Court shall pay mileage and other reasonable expenses to non-resident attorneys appointed under this plan at the rate adopted by Kenedy County or other law.

5.03. Investigative Expenses

a. Upon motion previously granted by the Juvenile Court, counsel shall be reimbursed for reasonable necessary expenses incurred, including for investigation and for mental health and other experts.

b. Counsel may request the advance payment of expenses in the same manner provided by Art. 26.052(f), Tx.C.Cr.P.

§5.04. Appeal expenses

Counsel shall be reimbursed for expenses in an appeal filed by a juvenile.

§5.05. Fee Schedule

The Juvenile Board adopts the fee schedule for the payment of attorney's fees and expenses as shown below:
