## §5.02. Mileage reimbursement

The Juvenile Court shall pay mileage and other reasonable expenses to non-resident attorneys appointed under this plan at the rate adopted by Kenedy County or other law.

5.03. Investigative Expenses

- a. Upon motion previously granted by the Juvenile Court, counsel shall be reimbursed for reasonable necessary expenses incurred, including for investigation and for mental health and other experts.
- b. Counsel may request the advance payment of expenses in the same manner provided by Art. 26.052(f), Tx,C.Cr.P.

## §5.04. Appeal expenses

Counsel shall be reimbursed for expenses in an appeal filed by a juvenile.
