

TRAVIS COUNTY FEE GUIDELINES FOR APPOINTED COUNSEL IN CIVIL CASES

(Cause Number D-1-GN-61-121012)

EFFECTIVE 4/1/2020 FOR SERVICES RENDERED ON OR AFTER THAT DATE:

Pursuant to C.C.P. Art. 26.05, and Texas Family Code section 107.015 and 51.10(i), the following guidelines shall be used to claim attorney's fees for appointed counsel in civil cases.

HOURLY RATES:

Appointed counsel will be compensated for time actually required by an appointment at an hourly rate not to exceed \$100 plus allowable expenses, as deemed necessary by the court with regards to effective representation of the party. The exact rate will be dependent upon the complexity of the case and the experience and ability of the appointed counsel. If an hourly rate is approved, an itemized statement reflecting the date, service performed, and time expended, must be submitted with the request for payment form.
