AMENDED STANDING ORDER REGARDING FEE
SCHEDULE FOR COURT-APPOINTED
ATTORNEYS IN WOOD COUNTY, TEXAS

COUNTY OF WOOD

Beginning January 1, 2014, the fee schedule set out below will replace the September 24, 2008, ordered schedule for Wood County, Texas.

Juvenile Cases

- 1. When State is not seeking commitment to TYC \$70 per hour
(The Court will pay for hours actually spent in trial, plus an equal number of additional hours as the "imputed" time spent in preparation for trial.)
- 2. When State is seeking commitment to TYC \$75 per hour
(The Court will pay for hours actually spent in trial, plus an equal number of additional hours as the "imputed" time spent in preparation for trial.)
- 3. Case disposed by plea (per client, not per case) \$300
- 4. Detention hearings \$150

Misdemeanor Cases

- 1. Cases disposed by plea (per client, not per case) \$350
- 2. Cases disposed by trial \$70 per hour
(The Court will pay for hours actually spent in trial, plus an equal number of additional hours as the imputed time spent in preparation for trial)

Non-Capital Felony Cases


- 1. Cases disposed by plea (per client, not per case) \$450
- 2. Cases disposed by trial \$75 per hour
(The Court will pay for hours actually spent in trial, plus an equal number of additional hours as the imputed time spent in preparation for trial)
- 3. Additional fee for cases returned to the Court regarding shock probation \$225


Other Cases

- Capital Felonies Negotiable
- Foster Care Docket \$75 per hour
- Attorney General \$70 per hour

(NOTE: The Court may adjust fees upward for extraordinary circumstances!)
