MAGISTRATE'S WARNING

THE STATE OF TEXAS
COUNTY OF YOUNG

Before me, the undersigned magistrate of Young County, Texas on the _____ day of _____, 20____,
at _____ o'clock ____ . m., appeared _____. I gave said person the following warning:

- ____ 1. You are charged with the offense of _____ a felony a misdemeanor.
- ____ 2. You have the right to hire an attorney to represent you.
- ____ 3. You have the right to have an attorney present prior to and during any interview and questioning by peace officers or attorneys representing the State.
- ____ 4. You have the right to remain silent.
- ____ 5. You are not required to make a statement, and any statement you make can and may be used against you in court.
- ____ 6. You have the right to stop any interview or questioning at any time.
- ____ 7. You have the right to have an examining trial (felonies only).
- ____ 8. You have the right to request an appointment of counsel if you cannot afford counsel.
- ____ 9. I, the magistrate in this case, have further in clear language understood by the accused person informed said accused person that:
- a. You have the right to request appointment of counsel if you cannot afford counsel.
 - b. The procedure for requesting appointment of counsel consists only of you, the accused person, completing the "Declaration of Inability to Hire Counsel and Affidavit of Indigence: and signing and swearing to the truthfulness of the statements contained in said affidavit.
 - c. I am providing you at this time a copy of the "Affidavit of Indigence and Request for Appointment of Counsel: in a language which you can understand and I will make available, at your request, an individual to provide reasonable assistance in completing the Affidavit at this time.
 - d. If you request court appointed counsel, I will not later than 24 hours from the time your request for appointment of counsel forward your Affidavit and Request to the appropriate judge for consideration of your Affidavit and Request.
 - e. If the judge finds you are entitled to court appointed counsel, that judge will appoint counsel within three (3) working days after receiving your request for court appointed counsel and will notify your appointed attorney of such appointment.
 - f. Said attorney will make every reasonable effort to contact you not later than the end of the first working day after appointment and to interview you as soon as possible.
- ____ 10. If you are not a United States citizen and you have been arrested or detained, you may be entitled to have us notify your country's consular representatives here in the United States. Do you want us to notify your country's consular officials: No Yes If yes, what country? _____
If you are a citizen of a country that requires us to notify your country's consular representative, we shall notify them as soon as possible.
