Effective for appointments on or after 10/15/25, compensation is as follows:

Criminal Law Board-Certified Attorney	\$100 per invoice
Trial by Court/Jury Trial	\$600 per day \$300 for half day
Appeals	\$50-\$125 per hour, not to exceed \$1,800

Counsel appointed to represent indigent defendants prior to March 20, 2024, shall be compensated for their services pursuant to the fee schedule in effect at the time of appointment. If the charging instrument alleges different charges in separate counts, the attorney may be compensated for each count under one case number by specifying the count number. The attorney may not be compensated for different charges alleged in separate counts that either (1) were added only for the purpose of facilitating a plea or (2) were alleged in the alternative and could not result in separate convictions. The attorney may not be compensated twice for board certification or for hearings and trials that involve all counts.
